

HOW TO TAKE NOTES USING A KINDLE

The Kindle is an e-book reader that allows user to add notes and annotations to any e-book they are reading via a QWERTY keyboard. These notes are accessible within the user's online Amazon account and can be shown to other Kindle users who are reading the same e-book. By adding a blank document to the Kindle, the device can also be used to write any notes that the user desires and to share the notes with others.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Create a new text document on a computer and give it a title such as “notes.txt”. Open the document and add a line of text that you will recognize on the Kindle, such as “Blank document for Kindle notes”. Save the text file.
2. Connect the Kindle to the computer using its USB cable and transfer the text document to the “documents” folder on the Kindle.
3. Turn the Kindle on and open the text document.
4. Press the “Menu” button and click the “add a note” link. Type your note and click the “save” button to save and close it.
5. To view your notes, open the text document, press the “Menu” button and click “View My Notes”.
