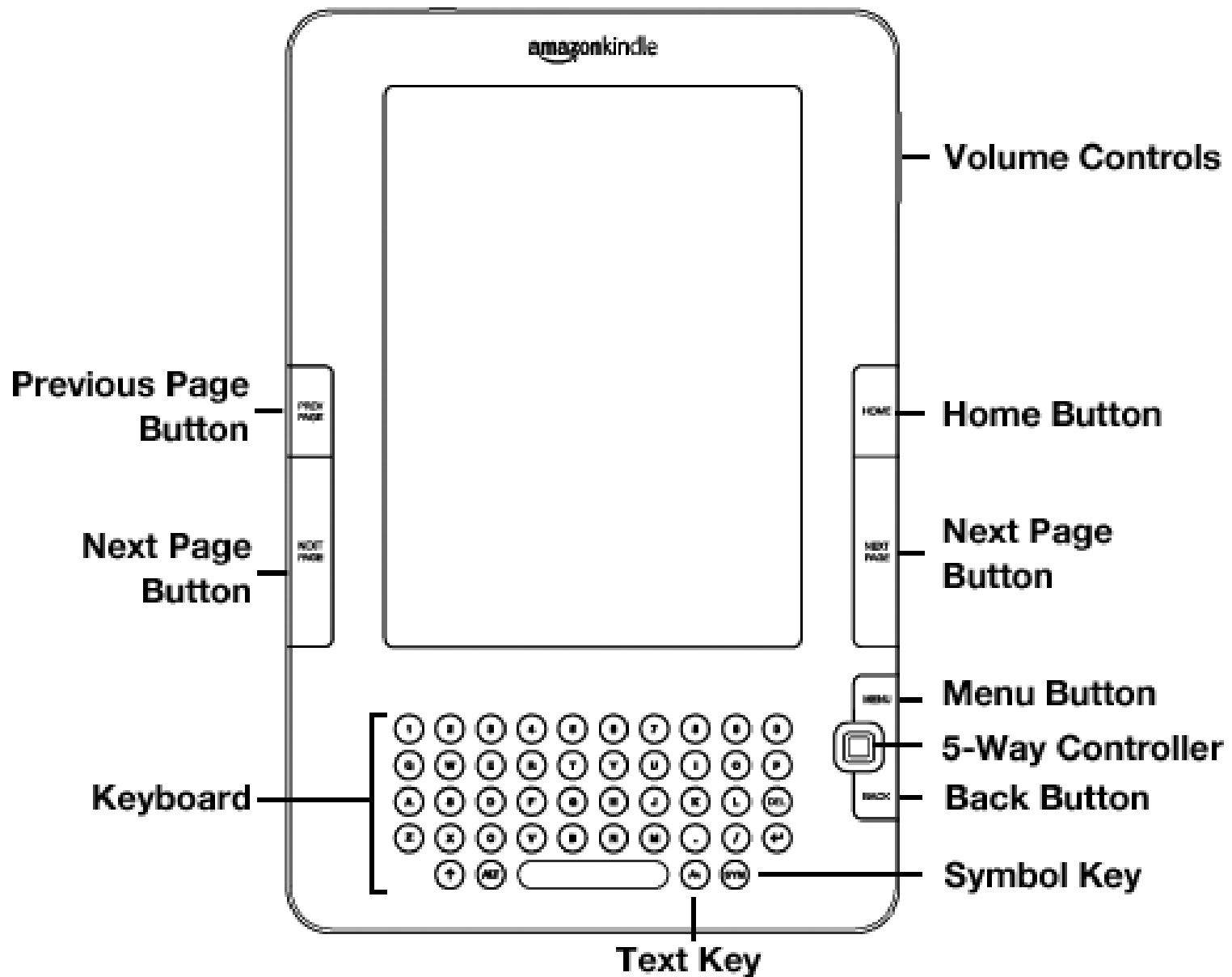

Menus: Settings

- Registration (or de-register)
- Popular Highlights (turn off or on)
- Social Networks (manage)
- Annotations Backup (turn off or on)
- Device Password

SUB-MENU: Restart, Reset to Factory Defaults, Legal and Sync

Menus: Experimental

- Depends on your Model
- Mine has: Basic Web, Play MP3, Text to Speech info.

Content: Sort

- Go to Home Page
- Navigate to Top Line
- Press 5-way Right to select Sort Option
- Options are: Most Recent first, Title, Author, Collections

Content: Collections

Create a Collection

- Menu, Create a New Collection

Use a Collection

- Find Book on Home (Content Manager)

Push 5-way Right

Selection Add to Collection

- Use Sort to view Collections
- To Edit a Collection, select it on Home, push 5-way Right

Content: Archive and Delete

To Archive (remove from device)

Go to book on Home Screen

Push 5-way to the left

Press 5-way to select “Remove from Device”

- ***Note: You can go to your Archive List (Menu, View Archived List) and delete permanently. If you change your mind, you will have to re-purchase the book***

Music

- Download or Copy

Download or copy MP3 songs or albums to your computer. Connect your Kindle to PC via USB. Copy music into Music folder on Kindle

Additional information at amazon.com

- To use music: Go to Home, Menu, Experimental and click Play Music

Notes, Bookmarks, Annotations

- Notes – Personal notes you type
- Annotations – Same thing
- Bookmarks – Kindle automatically bookmarks your place or you can add one yourself
- Highlights – Underlined text in a book

Press Menu while reading a book.

Manage Your Kindle

- Go to Amazon.com and sign in
Let's take a look.

Part IV – More Advanced

Kindle for PC

Free to download to your PC or MAC

Allows you to read on your PC and to sync with your Kindle.

Can also view Notes and Highlights

Part IV – More Advanced

Lending/Sharing

Go to Amazon.com, sign in

Click on Your Amazon, Your Library

Choose the book you want to Lend, click on Actions to see if it is a Lendable book.

Part IV – More Advanced

Transferring

Books can be transferred from one Kindle to another if the Kindles are registered under the same name. Up to 6 Kindles can be registered to the same account.

Part IV – More Advanced

PDF's (handout)

You can create your own documents, convert to PDF (using Open Office or Mobipocket) and copy to your Kindle for reading.

Part IV – More Advanced

Photos (handouts)

You can add your own photos (b&w) to your Kindle.

Attach Kindle to PC via USB, create a folder called Pictures, create a subfolder titled the subject of the pics (family, etc.), then copy photos (JPGs) from PC into folder.

Subfolder name will show up on Kindle list like a book title.
